What is the overall <u>deductible</u> ?	Medical & <u>Prescription Drug Deductible</u> : Tier 1: \$7,200 member / \$14,400 family Tier 2: \$8,700 member / \$17,400 family Benefits are administered on a calendar year basis.	Generally, you must pay all of the costs from <u>providers</u> up to the <u>deductible</u> amount before this plan begins to pay. If you have other family members on the <u>plan</u> , each family member must meet their own individual <u>deductible</u> until the total amount of <u>deductible</u> expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family <u>deductible</u> .
Are there services covered before you meet your <u>deductible</u> ?	Yes. <u>Preventive care</u> , Tiers 1 and 2 <u>prescription drugs</u> , and any combination of first 3 Primary Care <u>provider</u> office visits per member, and any combination of first 3 mental/behavioral health and substance use outpatient services per member are covered before you meet your <u>deductible</u> .
